Clubs from both Winter 2025 & Summer 2025/26 will receive notification from PlayHQ for individual players to register for the 2026 Winter season.

Warehouse Cricket will acknowledge EACH team nominated and refer clubs to ensure they complete the PlayHQ Team registration.

WCAQ REQUESTS CLUBS TO SUBMIT FORMS ANY TIME FROM THIS POINT.

By sending in forms early:

- Warehouse Cricket will have the time to process your clubs' nominations on PlayHQ &
- Clubs will then have time to ensure their players are correctly registered on PlayHQ for the coming season.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:



All players are required to register online, **even if currently playing a Summer competition.**

If you are changing Clubs for your winter season and are asked to complete a transfer, please proceed. This will NOT affect your current summer registration.

- The National Registration Fee (NRF) is valid for two consecutive seasons ie:
 - Winter 2025 & Summer 25/26 **OR**
 - Summer 25/26 & Winter 2026.

All players who first paid the NRF for Winter 2025 will be due to pay the NRF again in Winter 2026.

- Age Groups (U/12–U/16) depends on team numbers in an age group. Recent experience is that each year level is separate with Divisions in U/13 & U/14 age levels. (U15/16 play to Senior rules.)
- Age eligibility date 01/09/2025.

Competitions:

- **Saturdays:** Warehouse Cricket offers (Junior Competition & Senior Competition) - See separate information for Senior competitions.
- **Sundays** Warehouse Cricket offers **ONLY** Senior Grades (Fortnightly) Sunday 50 Over & T20 Competitions - See separate information for Senior competitions.
- Any Junior player participating in a Senior competition **must be at least 12 years old.** (14 Year old or higher is recommended)
