## Upon confirmation QLD Cricket will contact you within 1-2 business days confirming your team has been invited in ON PLAYHQ with these steps:

- Create your Team note that Warehouse will complete the Grade allocation step

#### Note:

Teams to submit nominations as early as possible to allow Queensland Cricket the time to process your clubs' nominations on PlayHQ and Clubs to then have players register as across.

- This confirmation will also include a Player Information Pack for the upcoming Winter season, support resources and upcoming Summer PlayHQ training / upskill opportunities.
- All players are required to register online, even if you are currently playing in the 2025 Winter competition.
- The National Registration Fee is valid for two consecutive seasons (ie Winter 2025 & Summer 25/26). So those who paid in the last summer, must pay again for this summer.

## PRE-CHRISTMAS - (Half) Season

## (Also suitable for Senior School Students) Aim of Competition:

Warehouse Cricket is aware that a number of Grade Clubs or Schools may have surplus players prior to Christmas. This competition will give Clubs an opportunity to keep young players connected to their Club. They will remain available for their Club selection but will be getting a game

each week otherwise. It also provides opportunities for Schools where players are committed for Term 1 school sport.

**Competition dates are flexible** - see options across with actual dates depending on number of nominating teams.

- 1. Played on Turf wickets
- 2. Pre-Christmas, as per dates across or as modified to reflect number of teams. Eg: could also be grade of 8 teams with 7 matches.
- 3. Based on Senior Saturday rules with relevant Cricket Australia bowling & safety restrictions where applicable.
- 4. Open to Grade Clubs and or School teams from upper secondary and senior players.
- 5. Where a team is primarily U/18, along with two senior players, Junior finance rates will apply.
- 6. Options include a Two day or One day format. (40 Over games) and be aligned to Grade cricket dates.
