Warehouse Cricket will:

- acknowledge EACH team nominated &
- advise Qld Cricket who will contact the club as across.

Note:

Teams to submit nominations as early as possible to allow Queensland Cricket the time to process your clubs' nominations on PlayHQ and Clubs to then have players register as across.



- Upon confirmation **QLD Cricket** will contact you within 1-2 business days confirming your team has been invited in PlayHQ and allowing you to complete your team nomination ON PLAYHQ with these steps:
 - Create your registration link
 - Create your Team – note that Warehouse will complete the Grade allocation step
- This confirmation will also include a Player Information Pack for the upcoming Winter season, support resources and upcoming Winter PlayHQ training / upskill opportunities.
- All players are required to register online, **even if currently playing a Summer competition.**
- The National Registration Fee (NRF) is valid for two consecutive seasons ie:
 - Winter 2024 & Summer 24/25 **OR**
 - Summer 24/25 & Winter 2025.
 (Those who first paid the NRF for Winter 2024, will be due to pay the NRF again in Winter 2025.)
- The NRF price remains unchanged at **\$16** for Juniors and **\$22.50** for Senior players.

- Age Groups (U/12–U/16) depends on team numbers in an age group. Recent experience is that each year level is separate with Divisions in U/13 & U/14 age levels. (U15/16 play to Senior rules.)
- Age eligibility date 01/09/2024.

- **Saturdays:** Warehouse Cricket offers (Junior Competition & Senior Competition) - See separate information for Senior competitions.
- **Sundays** Warehouse Cricket offers **only Senior Grades (Fortnightly) Sunday 50 Over & T20 Competitions** - See separate information for Senior competitions. Any Junior player participating in a Senior competition **must be at least 12 years old**. (14 Year old or higher is recommended)

WICKET FEES POLICY - WET WEATHER:

Synthetic	1 day	\$ 110.00
Turf	1 day	\$ 135.00
Synthetic	2 day	\$ 160.00
Turf	2 day	\$ 220.00

Wicket Fees are payable on all days where some play is possible. Where wet weather prevents a start of play that day, (ie: where Warehouse Cricket or the Ground Authority/Club or Warehouse Cricket) or the Officiating Umpire, deems that play cannot commence, then wicket fees are not payable for that day.

UMPIRES EXPENSES - \$70.00 per Team Per Day (where allocated)

- Such expenses are to be paid to the Umpire at the first break.
- Except for Finals: U/13 & U/14 games will only receive an umpire when numbers allow.
- U/12s will should not receive umpires at this time.



Code of Conduct:

All players & Club Officials in Warehouse Cricket competitions are subject to the conditions governing the rules of cricket and the Preamble covering the Spirit of the Game of Cricket.

Commitment to Competition. Forfeits are costly and deny your opposition a game.
