Clubs from both Winter 2026 & Summer 2025/26 will receive notification from PlayHQ for individual players to register for the 2026-27 Summer season.

Warehouse Cricket will acknowledge EACH team nominated and refer clubs to ensure they complete the PlayHQ Team registration.

WCAQ REQUESTS CLUBS TO SUBMIT FORMS ANY TIME FROM THIS POINT.

By sending in forms early:

- Warehouse Cricket will have the time to process your clubs' nominations on PlayHQ &
- Clubs will then have time to ensure their players are correctly registered on PlayHQ for the coming season



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

All players are required to register online, even if currently playing a Winter competition.

If you are changing Clubs for your summer season and are asked to complete a transfer, please proceed. This will NOT affect your current winter registration.

The National Registration Fee (NRF) is valid for two consecutive seasons ie:

- Winter 2026 & Summer 26/27 **OR**
- All players who first paid the NRF for Summer 2025/26 will be due to pay the NRF again in Summer 2026/27.

Aim of Competition:

Warehouse Cricket is aware that a number of Grade Clubs or Schools may have surplus players prior to Christmas. It also provides opportunities for Schools where players are committed for Term 1 school sport.
