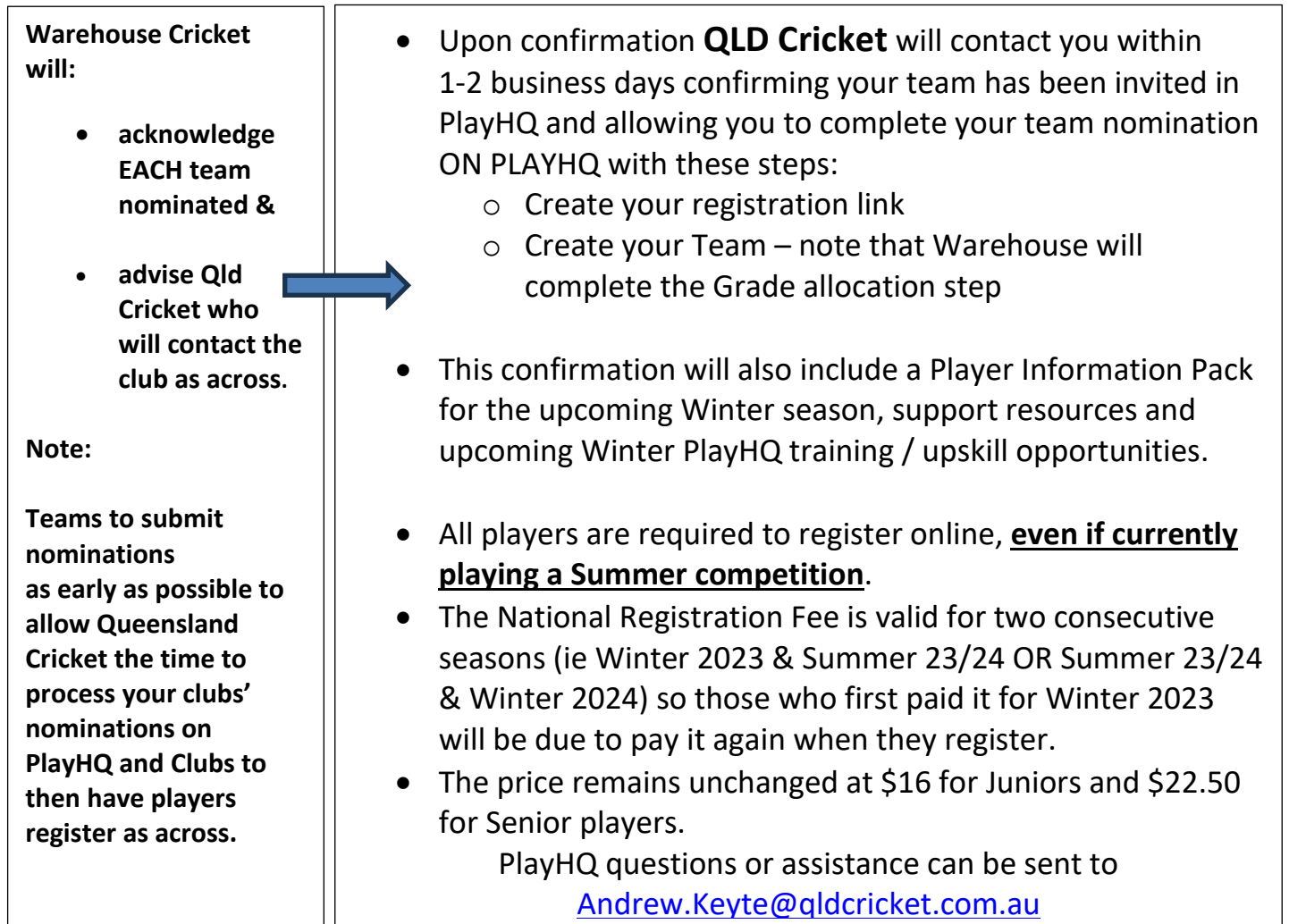
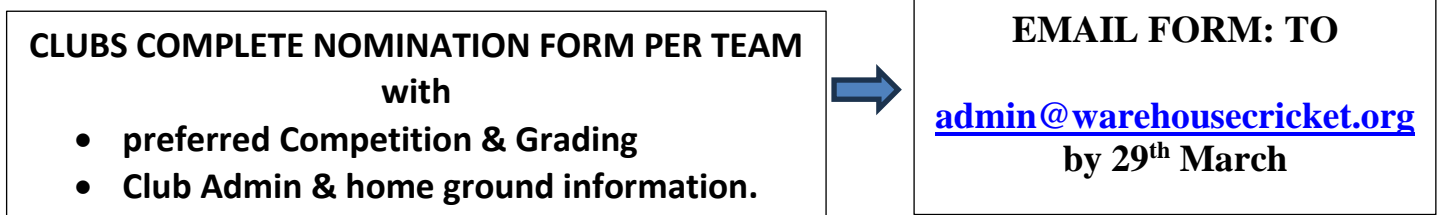

In response to the inaugural U/12 competition in 2023, Warehouse Cricket received almost universal feedback from both club officials and Qld Cricket for the format of the U12 competition resulting in a continuation of the program this winter.

Participation should be the focus for the U/12 Competition. Team coaches are encouraged to ensure all players have the opportunity to bat and bowl, where possible each game.

- Age Groups (U/12–U/16) depends on team numbers in an age group. Recent experience is that each year level is separate with Divisions in U/13 & U/14 age levels.
- Age eligibility date 01/09/2023.

- **Saturdays:** Warehouse Cricket offers (Junior Competition & Senior Competition) - See separate information for Senior competitions.
- **Sundays** Warehouse Cricket offers **only Senior Grades (Fortnightly) Sunday 50 Over & T20 Competitions** - See separate information for Senior competitions. Any Junior player participating in a Senior competition must be at least 12 years old.

WICKET FEES POLICY - WET WEATHER:

Synthetic	1 day	\$ 105.00
Turf	1 day	\$ 125.00
Synthetic	2 day	\$ 150.00
Turf	2 day	\$ 200.00

Wicket Fees are payable on all days where some play is possible. Where wet weather prevents a start of play that day, (ie: where Warehouse Cricket or the Ground Authority/Club or Warehouse Cricket) or the Officiating Umpire, deems that play cannot commence, then wicket fees are not payable for that day.

UMPIRES EXPENSES - \$70.00 per Team Per Day (where allocated)

Such expenses are requested to be paid to the Umpire at the first break, where possible.

Except for Finals: U/13 & U/14 games will only receive an umpire when numbers allow. U/12s will not receive umpires at this time.



Code of Conduct:

All players & Club Officials in Warehouse Cricket competitions are subject to the conditions governing the rules of cricket and the Preamble covering the Spirit of the Game of Cricket.
